#### **Overview of EuroVelo**

- Initiative coordinated by the European Cyclists' Federation (ECF), the voice of civil society on cycling in Europe
- Created in 1997, EuroVelo will turn 28 years old in 2025!
- 17 routes, in 38 countries
- 91,000+ km of cycle routes when completed 61,000+ km of developed routes (67%) - 35,000+ km signed with EuroVelo signs (39%)
- Backbone for national cycle route networks a Transport and tourism network
- A truly branded Europe product
- A connected **methodology** to assess the quality of long distance cycle routes: European Certification Standard (ECS)

Innovative participatory sustainable business model for cycling along the Iron Curtain Trail

- Co-funded by the Interreg Central Europe Programme
- 12 Partners from 9 countries (PL, DE, HR, HU, SI, AT, SK, CZ, + BE)
- Start date: 03/2023, end date: 02/2026 (36 months)
- Project budget: 2,67 M EUR

#### Project goals:

- ICTr-CE
- To develop an innovative and participatory business model, supporting the ICTr-CE tourism products with booking functionality
- stimulate the rural and urban SME's to collaborate, develop joint tourism offers and further develop their economic performance
- enhance human competences through an effective training/mentoring programme for SMEs
- Develop a cooperation framework in order to ensure the sustainability and transferability of project results



#### Project goals:



- To focus on the socio, economic and environmental impacts of the tourism sector - adapt a Footprint Calculator, develop and test an impact measurement system
- Develop the ICTr Good Impact valorisation programme
- Extend the jointly developed solution to other EuroVelo routes

### Results after 2 year

- A comprehensive survey was launched in all countries (to identify territorial needs and digital competences)
- The framework of the business model was developed
- The backbone of the tourism product was developed
- CO2 footprint calculator + IMS are developed
- Training events were organized
- Explorer tours were organized in each pilot area
- Started to work on the sustainability of our results (STP, ICTr Alliance)

#### Pilot actions

- We developed a complex guideline how to implement a pilot action
- We have to test the ICTr cycling product (WP1) and its innovative elements (WP2)
- We have 2 booking centers (AT, SI)! Capacity building programme for BCs
- Step-by-step implementation approach (desk research, field trip, explorer tours)
- Started in May, will be ended in October 2025

The solutions have to be applicable in other EuroVelo routes










### Last year of project implementation






